The identity of the client or the specifications of the individual sessions are not subject to access by the organization or be disclosed by professionals without prior, informed consent of the concerned client.
- · In situations where the counselling sessions exceed the maximum number, i.e., 10 sessions within the financial year, the consultancy fee for the booked sessions will have to be borne by the individuals themselves. The consultancy fees per session is Rs. 1500/-.
- · The sessions can be held in both online or off-line mode, depending upon the comfort of the individual.
